Bulk Purchases as arranged by the District Secretary:

- Honey jars: These are usually available to order in early Spring with minimum order being half a gross. 2022 price £54 per gross. Orders with payment required by the specified date.
- Invert sugar syrup and bee fondant (12x1kg boxes). Usually available to order and purchase late summer. Latest available price £16 but may change
- Varroa treatments Sometimes available: likely to be ApiBioxal in late Autumn
