

Classes of Membership

1. **Renewing Full Membership (for existing Full members): £31.00**

As agreed at the Jan 2023 AGM, the District Fee of £3.50 has been reintroduced with effect from 2024 renewals.

An active beekeeper or someone wishing to be treated as such becomes a member of the local District, Lincolnshire Beekeepers' Association (LBKA) and British Beekeepers' Association (BBKA).

As a voting member of LBKA:

- Attend LBKA events
- Attend District events

As a Registered member of BBKA:

- Receive BBKA News magazine monthly
- Attend BBKA events
- Product and Public liability insurances to £10 million
- From BDI, brood disease insurance for the first 3 colonies included in the membership fee (additional premiums for more than 3 colonies as follows £1.20 for 2 extra, £4.70 for 7 extra, £7.75 for 12 extra, £9.50 for 17 extra, £11.10 for 22 extra, £13.60 for 27 extra).

2. **Partner Member: £19.25**

A member who is an active beekeeper with all rights as above except that they share BBKA and LBKA publications with the Full Member who lives at the same address. BDI paid by Full member.

3. **Local (formally called Associate Member): £3.50**

A member who is not an active beekeeper with access to all District activities and some LBKA activities at the discretion of the organisers.

NB. A completed application form is still required in order to comply with GDPR Regulations.

4. **Country Member: £14.50**

An Associate Member (ie non- beekeeper) who wishes to opt into BBKA. Receives BBKA News but does not receive any of the BBKA insurances.

5. **Junior Member: £9.50:** Beekeeper under 18.

Membership runs from **1st Jan to 31st Dec.** **New** members joining after 1st Sept have membership to the end of the following year. BDI cover applies January 1st to December 31st or for the remainder of the year after late payment.

NB. A late payment fee of £10 payable by renewing members if annual subs not received by February 2024 district meeting
